- A Sunshine Committee

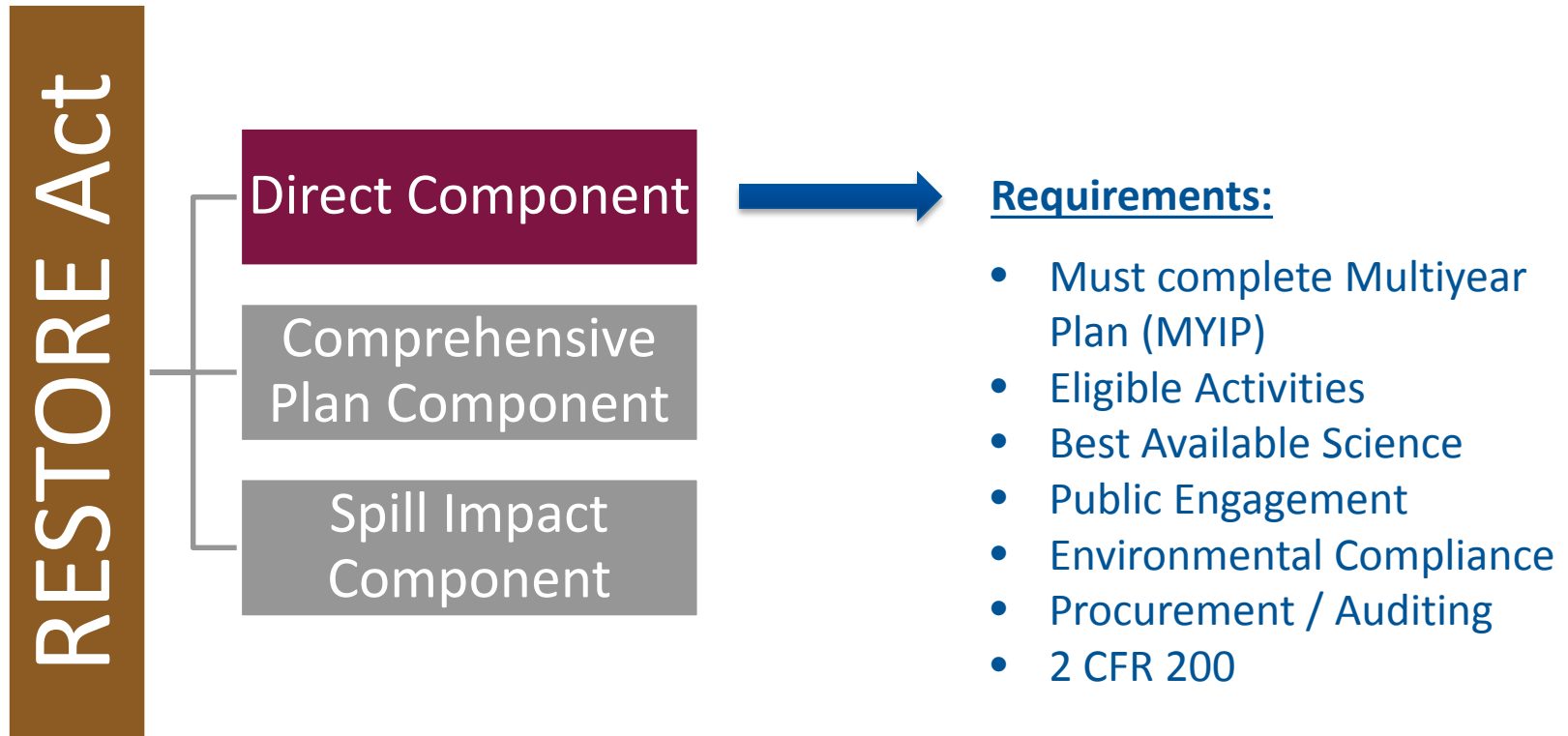

# RESTORE Direct Component Eligible Activities

- (1) Restoration and protection of the natural resources, ecosystems, fisheries, marine and wildlife habitats, beaches and coastal wetlands of the Gulf Coast region;
- (2) Mitigation of damage to fish, wildlife, and natural resources;
- (3) Implementation of a federally approved marine, coastal, or comprehensive conservation management plan, including fisheries monitoring;
- (4) Workforce development and job creation;
- (5) Improvements to or on State parks located in coastal areas affected by the Deepwater Horizon oil spill;
- (6) Infrastructure projects benefitting the economy or ecological resources, including port infrastructure;
- (7) Coastal flood protection and related infrastructure;
- (8) Planning assistance;
- (9) Administrative costs;
- (10) Promotion of tourism in the Gulf Coast region, including recreational fishing;
- (11) Promotion of the consumption of seafood harvested from the Gulf Coast region

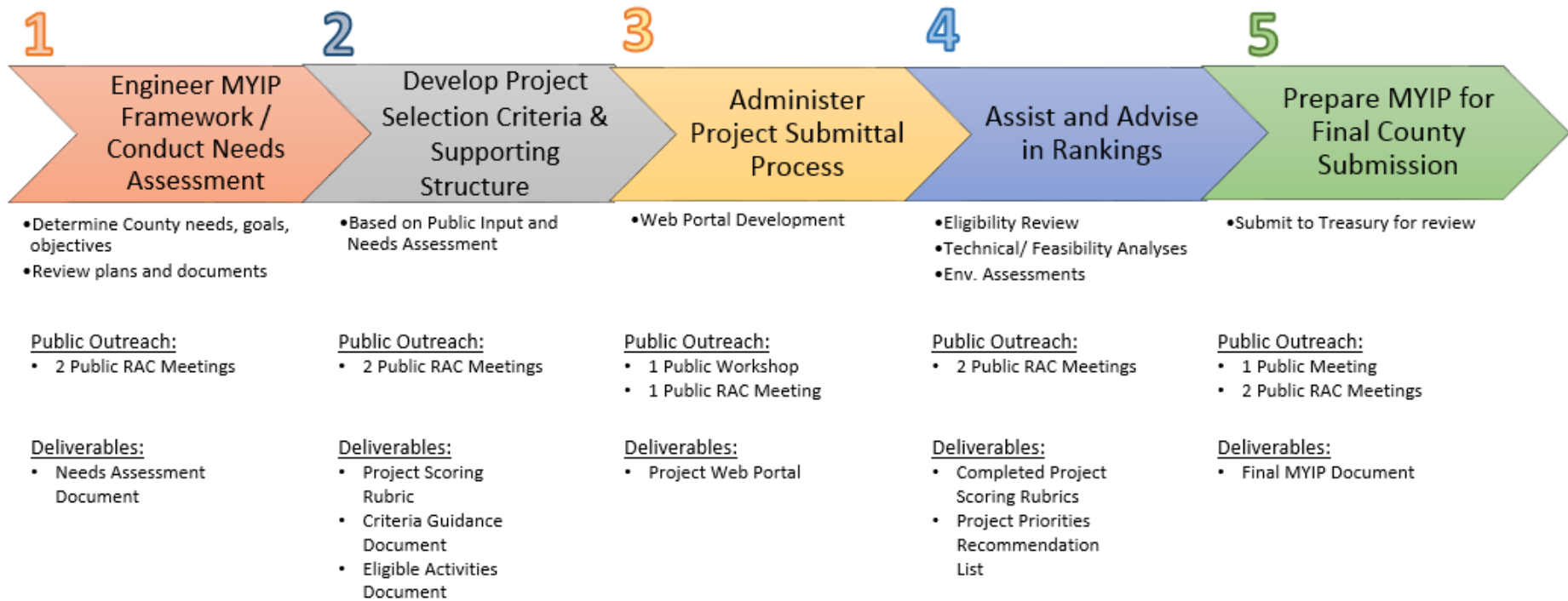

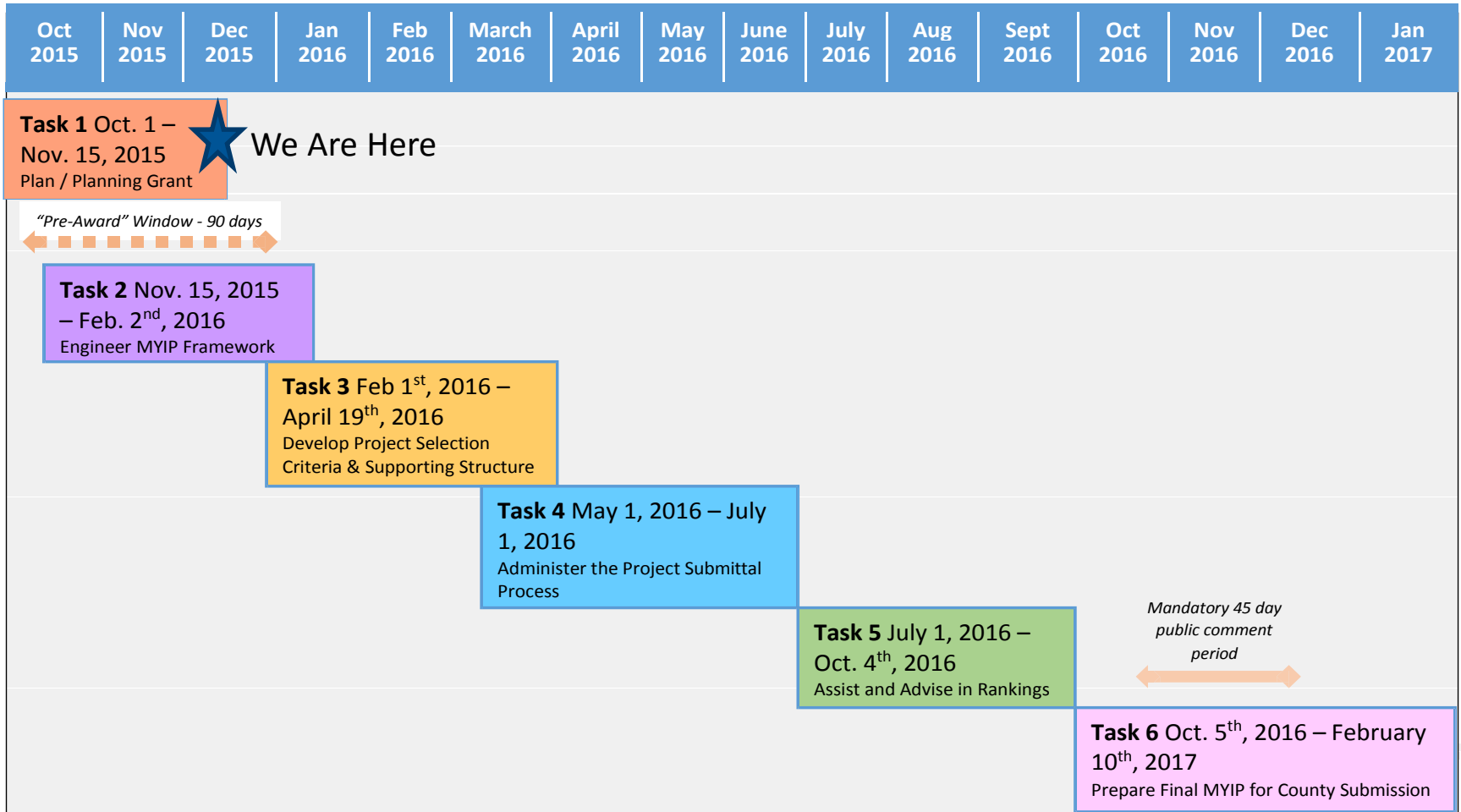
